### Year Ended December 31, 2022

### 1. DESCRIPTION OF ORGANIZATION

The Society was incorporated November 20, 2009, as Awamu Africa Society and changed its name to Niteo Africa Society on July 20, 2010, under the laws of the Province of British Columbia and is registered as a charity under the Canadian Income Tax Act.

Niteo Africa Society was established to create partnerships of Ugandans and Canadians focused on enriching life-wide literacy communities through books, capacity-building, and reciprocal partnerships.

### 2. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of Niteo Africa Society as at December 31, 2022, and the statements of receipts and disbursements and changes in net assets and cash flows for the year then ended is the historical cost basis and reflects cash transactions with the addition of:

- contributions receivable
- goods and services tax recoverable
- accounts payable and accrued liabilities
